

Edward Reist August 9, 1901 – January 1, 1988

Ed Reist 86, Bern, Kansas died Friday, January 1, 1988. He was born on August 9, 1901 near DuBois, Nebraska to John and Sophia (Kunz) Reist.

He was married to Pauline J. Hildebrand on December 24, 1930. They had 3 Children: Robert and two daughters. Nedra and Janell.

He was baptized April 14, 1902, at the Fourmile church near Humboldt, Nebraska and Confirmed March 15, 1910, in the Friedens Church and later became a member of the Evangelical Church in Bern and later the United Methodist Church.
