August 13, 1905 – March 14, 1995

Mrs. July (Eiserman) Rodgers Egge formerly of New Haven, Missouri, died last Tuesday, March 14, 1995, in Appleton, Wisconsin, at the home of one of her grandchildren, Chuck and Pam "Maxine" Rohrs. She was 89.

Mrs. Egge was born on August 13, 1905, in New Haven, Missouri, the daughter of Henry and Louise (Shirley) Eiserman.

One daughter, Shirley Rodgers, taught school in Hermann and New Haven. One granddaughter, Jacque VanDoorn of Tennessee lived in Hermann for several years and wrote the neighbors column for the Advertiser-Courier.

Graveside services were held on Saturday, March 18, 1995, at the New Haven, Missouri Cemetery. There was no visitation.
